



TASTING NOTES

Mission Estate Marlborough Pinot Gris 2020



Viticulture

85% of the fruit for this wine is sourced from our superb Cable Station Road vineyard in the Awatere Valley, Marlborough. Cooling sea breezes encourage intense varietal flavour and great freshness in the mouth. 15% of the fruit is sourced from Hawke's Bay vineyards to add weight, richness and fullness to the blend due to the warmer climate.

Winemaking

The fruit was lightly pressed with minimal skin contact. By fermenting the juice in stainless steel tanks at low temperature the varietal flavour in the fruit is fully retained. The wine was aged on yeast lees to achieve optimum balance and full mouthfeel.

Tasting Notes

A medium-dry style with delicate pear and tropical fruit aromas. The palate is full showing intense ripe citrus, baked apple and vibrant pear character with a fine structure and a long off-dry finish.
